Where and when are the Chapter Meetings held?

The Knoxville Chapter meets on the **third Tuesday of each month**, September through May, at **Bridgewater Place**, 205 Bridgewater Rd, Knoxville. Meetings typically feature networking and presentations by experts on current topics. In addition, the Chapter hosts spring and holiday social events and CPE seminars in both fall and spring. Some meetings include fun outings or holiday gatherings for more relaxed interaction between Members and Partners.

What activities does the chapter offer in addition to chapter meetings?

The chapter hosts **two CPE days** each year: a fall session offering 4 CPE credits and a spring session offering 7 CPE credits. In addition, the chapter organizes a **Holiday Party** at Fleming's Steakhouse in December, where members may bring a spouse or guest, and a **summer social called FEI Esta** in early June at Zoo Knoxville, a family-friendly event with food, drinks, and activities for all ages.

What is the difference between a Member and a Partner?

Members are senior financial executives who engage in professional development, peer networking, and chapter activities. **Partners** work with Chapter leadership to provide networking opportunities, access to senior decision-makers at member companies, and opportunities to deliver technical or general interest presentations. Partners help build mutually beneficial relationships with members, support the development of future financial executives through the Chapter's scholarship program, and may bring prospective new members to meetings. While members focus on personal and professional growth, partners contribute to the overall quality and success of the Chapter and the Knoxville business community.
